Ph.D. Funded & New Pub

Grad student **Denita Weeks** was recently awarded The Van Vleet Memorial Doctorial Award (\$16,000 renewable for 4 years with tuition waiver) from the University of Memphis, where she will begin her Ph.D. program this fall. Weeks plans to study the ecology of amphibian diseases. The fellowship was established in 1964 by the family of McKay Van Vleet, a Memphis civic leader and business executive, to attract outstanding doctoral students in the sciences.

The first chapter of Weeks's MS thesis is now in press in the *Journal of Thermal Biology*: "Lizards on ice: comparative thermal tolerances of the world's southernmost gecko." Dr. **Robert Espinoza** is her coauthor.
