1. Welcome to the Committee, and introduction of members to each other

3. Budget picture

California and the CSU do not yet have FY 2010-11 budgets. Until we do, Academic Affairs and the Library are doing the best they can based on previous years' numbers and current estimates of funding.

4. Elizabeth Altman: Demonstrate new Library web pages

The Library recently activated its newest web page information and layouts. Elizabeth Altman, Library Systems Web Services Coordinator demonstrated and discussed the changes. She also asked members to let her know if they find problems or have suggested changes.

5. Dean Arnold & Rueyling Tsay: Demonstration of Library's new Video Furnace video streaming service

Library staff Dean Arnold, Music & Media Supervisor, and Rueyling Tsay, University Video Network (UVN) Coordinator demonstrated the technology and described the Library's transition from the current online classroom analog video/audio distribution system (UVN) to the improved online classroom digital video/audio distribution system: the *Video Furnace*. This process will take several months and faculty will be kept up-to-date.
