# **Library Dean Susan Curzon's Announcements**

- 1. Library Update:
  - The Library's newest exhibit in the Tseng Gallery is 50 and Fabulous...an exhibition celebrating CSUN's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. Everyone is invited to this free exhibit. There soon will also be an online digital exhibit of 50 and Fabulous. We will send out the URL when it is ready for viewing.
  - On Wednesday, Sept. 24<sup>th</sup>, the Friends of the Oviatt Library presented a talk by CSUN alum Kathy Kohner-Zuckerman, the real-life Gidget. It was a charming and entertaining event.

- 2. Librarian Michael Barrett explained the process of working with bibliographers and ordering materials through Library Collection Development. Among other things, he showed web sites listing contact info for subject specialist librarians and online request forms for books, cd's, etc.
- 3. Danielle Ste. Just, Supervisor of Library Reserves, Periodicals & Microform gave the committee an overview of the Library Reserves program and online booking system, and how best to put something on reserve and e-reserve for their students.
