- A. E. Adams announced that the Chancellor's Office issued a coded memo clarifying the "C or better" requirement for Basic Subjects. Because of inconsistencies in the use of plus/minus grading across the CSU system, a grade of C- is considered passing for the purpose of EO 1100. A revised CSUN Basic Skills Policy with the editorial change will be circulated electronically to EPC members for a vote so the policy revision can move forward to Senate Executive Committee for review.
- B. L. Becker reminded the committee that the 2016-2017 EPC chair will be elected at the next meeting. He also mentioned that committee members will remain the same for next year with the exception of the student and presidential appointees.
